



Conditions for transport to sports clubs

General information

Role of Bink

Bink is only responsible for transportation from the out-of-school care (bso) location to the sports club. This service is available for children aged 6 and older. No Bink staff member is present during the training session.

Supervision up to the sports club

A pedagogical staff member or a Bink-employed driver escorts the children from the bso to the entrance of the sports field or gym. From there, the children walk independently to their sports activity.

Team assignment and training times

The sports club decides which team your child will join and at what time the training takes place. Bink has no role in this.

Registering for transport

As soon as you know the day and time of your child's training, register your child via the online form on our website.

Transport confirmation

Our transport planner will inform you when transport can start. Please note that transport is only possible if there are enough buses and drivers available.

Changes to training time or day

Additional conditions for alternative transport

If no Bink driver is available, the bso will try to arrange alternative transportation. This is only possible if there is enough staff available in accordance with the required child-to-staff ratio. The safety and quality of care always come first.

No transport during holidays or breaks

Bink does not provide transport during school holidays or during the winter and summer break. This also applies to alternative locations or gyms where training continues.

Liability

Bink is not responsible for the loss of or damage to clothing or personal belongings at the sports club grounds.

Annual registration

This arrangement applies per school year. You must register your child again for each new season.

How does transport to the sports club work?

- Transport is only available if the training starts at or before 6:00 PM.
- Children change into their sportswear at the bso. Please ensure they wear easy-to-change sports clothing on training days.
- A Bink driver picks up your child from the bso and brings them to the sports club on time.
- Your child is signed out at the bso upon departure.
- Upon arrival, children walk independently to the sports field or gym. The driver does not accompany them further.
- Bink's responsibility ends once your child exits the bus.
- During training, responsibility lies with the sports club and its coaches.

How does transport back to the bso work?

- **For bso locations in Soest and bso Sportkids in Hilversum, Bink only provides transport to the sports club.** You are responsible for picking up your child afterwards.
- For other bso locations: if the training ends at 5:00 PM or earlier, and if possible, the driver will bring your child back to the bso. If the training ends later, you must pick up your child yourself.
- You are always welcome to pick up your child yourself. If someone else is picking up your child, please inform the bso in advance. Without prior notice, the driver is not allowed to release your child.



Conditions for transport to sports clubs

- The driver will wait with the bus at the entrance of the sports field.
- Children walk back to the bus independently. Bink resumes responsibility once your child gets on the bus.
- Upon return to the bso, your child will be signed back in.

What do we expect from you as a parent?

- Discuss these arrangements with your child beforehand.
- Share any medical or other important information relevant to our drivers.
- Visit the sports club with your child in advance so they know where to go.
- Provide appropriate sportswear. Without it, your child cannot participate, and we cannot provide transport.
- Explain to your child who they can turn to with questions or concerns at the sports facility.
